TOPIC: Pipe Supply and Fabrication Jackson, Ohio

MEETING SPEAKER: The speakers will be Mr. Rick Smith, President, Iron City Pipe and Supply, and Mr. Erik Massie, Vice President, Geiger Brothers. Mr. Scott Massie, President, Geiger Brothers, will also participate.

MEETING THEME: Following registration and networking from 5:30 to 6:00 p.m., guests will tour and hear about the quality aspects of pipe, valve and fitting (PVF) distribution at Iron City.

Following the presentation, dinner will be provided at no charge to attending guests.

Following dinner, guests will depart and make a five-minute drive for the second part of the program. The location is the fabrication shop at Geiger Brothers Mechanical Contractors, 317 Ralph Street, Jackson.
