QUALITY SOCIETY SETS FALL CONFERENCE FOR OCTOBER 8

The Scioto Valley Section of the American Society for Quality (ASQ) has planned its second annual Fall Conference for Friday, October 8, at the Adena Health System PACCAR Medical Education Center near Chillicothe, Ohio.

Primary conference speakers will address the future of nuclear energy, recent issues with Toyota automotive recalls, food safety, and geologic mapping.

In addition, one of two afternoon break-out tracks will be specifically geared toward food and agriculture, while the second will include sessions on "green" and alternative energy and then transportation infrastructure inspection.

The morning keynote speaker is Mr. Steve Leggett, senior lead quality improvement coach for healthcare and automotive suppliers at Lean Principles, LLC, Detroit. Leggett will address quality related issues and solutions surrounding recent Toyota safety recalls.

The afternoon keynote and closing speaker is Mr. Peter Smith, Director of Nuclear Development-Licensing and Engineering for Detroit Edison Company. Smith will address "The Future of Nuclear Energy" including need for additional capacity, worldwide status of nuclear development, changes to the licensing process, reactor technologies, and nuclear quality assurance.

The general registration fee is \$95. Registration deadline is October 1. There is a \$3.99 fee charged by the service provider for on-line registration. The conference brochure is located on pages 7 and 8 of this newsletter.

The rate for companies registering more than three associates is \$85 each. Student and retiree registration is \$75. Those requesting special rates must register by mail.

ASQ members holding certification will earn 1.0 recertification unit (RU) for attending this conference.

CALL FOR INSTRUCTORS

Interested section candidates who would like to teach an upcoming ASQ/CQE pre cert. course for Emerson Electric in Ironton, Ohio should contact Cindy Davis at www.d2associates.org or cldavis@d2associates.org.

Class will commence in fall of 2010 and will be held either at the host facility (or local college campus) depending on the headcount and if open to the local ASQ/SVS community. Emerson ASQ contacts are circulating course posting to facility employees.

This effort will be a six week commitment on the part of the instructor; one evening per week for six weeks. Depending on the student (and instructor availability) course timing may be 6-9 PM or 6-8 PM. The hour difference is up to instructor and student base - they can either do assignments on their own time post weekly session/or on site as a group. Course materials utilized will be the Indiana Council for Quality ASQ/CQE prep CD and manual. This will include instructor manual, student manual and other recommended reading lists (for students to compile on their own). I can provide details to all interested instructor candidates.

We have a vast talent pool available within our ranks. Please consider this opportunity. Course instructor should have prior CQE experience, have CQE certification and/or prior knowledge of how ASQ certification courses run (how to work through the certification materials) Those who have taught ASQ courses in the past may be of help to the CQE instructor if mentoring is needed. This is a fee based course and CQE instructor will be compensated for their time/mileage reimbursement allowance included.

Interested course instructor candidate should not currently be acting as ASQ test site proctor. Past experience ok, but one of the ASQ requirements is not to currently hold this voluntary position within the Section.

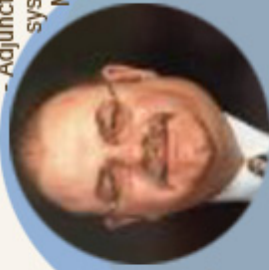
