**SPEAKER:** Erica Cheetham, is the Quality Director at the Robert C. Byrd Institute for Advanced Manufacturing (RCBI) in Huntington, WV. Erica has a Master of Science degree in Adult and Technical Education with an emphasis in Training and Development. In addition, she has received training and certification in Lean Manufacturing from the Lean Enterprise Institute in Brookline, Massachusetts, and Lean Six Sigma Black Belt Training at the Fisher College of Business at the Ohio State University.

**PRESENTATION:** As many of you are aware, the ISO 9001: 2008 Standard has been revised for 2015. It is currently in the Draft International Stage (ISO/DIS 9001). It is anticipated that the final Standard will be published early in 2015. Significant changes have been made resulting in complete re-organization and re-numbering of the clauses within the Standard. Changes include greater emphasis on managing processes, and it appears that Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) will be required for each process.

### Richard Biehle

As a Section Director for the ASQ Scioto Valley Section his role and responsibilities are:

Richard P. Biehle was born May 30, 1941 in Norfolk, Nebraska. He attended grade and junior high schools in Norfolk and graduated from Norfolk Senior High School in 1959. After high school he attended Nebraska Christian College for one year and then joined the US Navy. He served as a Hospital Corpsman at Naval Hospital Yokosuka, Japan, onboard the USS Topeka (GLC 8), and a destroyer tender, the USS Frontier. Richard returned to Norfolk, worked at Norfolk State Hospital, enrolled at Norfolk Junior College and then Wayne State College, Wayne, Nebraska. He graduated with a BS in Chemistry in 1969.

After Wayne State he was employed by A. E. Staley Manufacturing Company as a chemist and attended Illinois State University graduating with a MS in Chemistry in 1972. He was employed by Ashland Oil Inc. in 1972 as a laboratory supervisor and over the years migrated through various management positions including Laboratory Manager and Quality Manager. In 1998 Ashland and Marathon Oil combined and Richard served as a Senior Chemist until Retirement in 2000 from Marathon-Ashland Petroleum. His duties included being the ASTM voting member for Ashland and Marathon-Ashland on Committee D2.

In 2000 Biehle formed a consulting company (Biehle and Associates) which provided technical support and quality management direction to various corporations, businesses, schools, and non-profit organizations.

For over 20 years Mr. Biehle taught quality management, quality statistics, and organic and inorganic chemistry courses at Ashland Community and Technical College (ATCT). He has been a substitute teacher at local schools in the Russell, KY area.

Richard married Martha Elaine Babcock in 1966. They had one child, Linn Dyan Chetty currently of Austin, Texas. Marti died of breast cancer in 1980. In 1981 he married Harriet Jo Cornwell and acquired two sons, John (Wheelersburg, Ohio) and Wellington (Largo, FL.). Jo Biehle has been recognized as the Kentucky Teacher of the Year in 2001 and is a Milken Award Winner and a National Board Certified Teacher. They have four granddaughters.

Notable accomplishments for Richard include certifications as ASQ CQE, CQM, and CQA. Blackbelt training from G. E. Plastics. Voting member for ASTM Committee D 02 which writes the standards for automotive, diesel, and aviation fuels. He served on the Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award Board of Examiners for five years and as a judge for the Kentucky Quality Award for six years. He has received a Teaching Excellence Award from ACTC, the Award of Appreciation and Award of Excellence from ASTM, the P. M. Serokis Award from Aristech Chemical Company, and the Bronze Award from G. E. Plastics for a supplier black belt project. He has synthesized and characterized four new monomers and two new polymers.

Neat things include going to sea on the USS Kentucky (SSBN 737), working in Nigeria, traveling in the US and Canada, and studying the Chinese language and culture.

Mr. Biehle was the first chairman and a founding member of the subsection that encompassed Eastern Kentucky and Western West Virginia of the Lexington, KY ASQ Section. This area is now included in the Scioto Valley Section. He has been a Scioto Valley Section Director for a number of years.
